


Background

- Around 1998 I started to get curious about family history and so began to do research
- Curious about my grandmother's background, I interviewed her and was told:
 - Mardell was told by her mother Nellie that her birth father (Eugene Huntley) died of pneumonia shortly before she was born (Feb 2, 1908 in Clinton IA)
 - Mardell did not have a birth certificate and so her mother had to do an affidavit for Mardell to certify her birth (I confirmed this with vital records request to IA)
 - Also, of interest, Mardell often joked about her ancestry saying maybe her dad was a "horse thief"
 - My personal interpretation of this was that she suspected she was not told the truth about her father

- Found her in the 1880 census in Michigan
- Could not find her in 1900 census
- 1910 census showed Nellie and Mardell in Colorado Springs CO

First Indication – Something's Not Right

 While researching Nellie Spencer Huntley at the Sutro Library in San Francisco I found her in City Directories for Clinton IA and Cedar Rapids IA



Death Record for Eugene Huntley

- Married 29 Sep 1900
- Widowed 26 Oct 1900
- Married only 27 days



CLEARLY, Eugene could not have been Mardell's biological father

Sudden Family Move in 1908

 Careful scrutiny of Clinton IA, Cedar Rapids IA, and Colorado Springs CO City Directories indicate:

 Possible sudden move of the entire family from Cedar Rapids to Colorado Springs (keep in mind Mardell was born Feb 1908)


Where Does the Paper Trail Lead Us?

- Nellie Huntley was married and widowed in 1900 in Cedar Rapids IA
- Nellie lived in both Cedar Rapids and Clinton IA between 1900 and 1907
- Mardell Huntley was born in 1908 in Clinton IA
- No record of birth
- By 1908 Nellie and her family had relocated to Colorado Springs CO


• End of the paper trail?? Time to focus on DNA....

Joan's DNA

- Hoping DNA would answer this puzzle
- Tested my mother, Joan, in 2013 on Ancestry
- Ideally, one would expect 1/4th of Joan's DNA to be inherited from Mardell's father




Heavy Use of Ancestry's "Tag Groups"

- Emphasis on:
 - Phasing out matches from the other 3 grandparent lines
 - Identifying those unknown genetic networks ("DNA islands")



Analysis of Joan's Matches


- Nellie had only one child
- Mardell had only one child
 - Eliminates possibility of Joan having maternal aunt/uncles/cousins descended from Nellie
- Analysis of all of Joan's DNA matches between 20 cMs and 400 cMs (2,899 matches)
 - 80% of her identified matches are on paternal side
 - 18% are on known maternal grandmother side
 - ~2% are possibly maternal grandfather




Goal: Identify DNA Matches on Maternal Grandfather's Line

- Few likely matches identified, none above 120 cMs
- To identify the matches I use:
 - Not matched to the other 3 lines (as best as I can tell)
 - Look for matches with trees placing ancestors in Iowa/Illinios 1900-1910

Suspected Strongest Match on This Line


- Have reached out to him and he helped me build a tree for him






Keeping Geographical Proximity In Mind

- Nellie resided in both Clinton and Cedar Rapids in the 1900 decade
- Some DNA match trees had family in Hanover in 1900 decade



and Transportation...

- Union Pacific line between Clinton and Cedar Rapids was in effect in 1900s decade
- So there was a viable route between the two for the family to travel





Tried Everything I Could Think Of

- Grouping shared matches
- Upload to other services to find testers not on Ancestry
- Cluster Analysis (GEDmatch, DNAGedcom, GeneticAffairs)
- Leeds Method
- Build trees for cousins believed to be on this line
 - Looked for male, age 25-40, living in either Clinton or Cedar Rapids
 - Searched 1910 census in the two cities for occurrences of surnames

Why is this so difficult??

- Perhaps the father was recent immigrant with few DNA relatives in Ancestry database
- Both Joan and Mardell were only children --- eliminates opportunities for close relatives (aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, etc.)
- Perhaps the father actually descends from part of one of the other 3 groups
 - One note: I did run the GEDMatch "Are My Parents Related" on Joan's DNA kit and result was negative this would seemingly remove the option that the unidentified grandfather was related to Joan's paternal side
 - Doubtful there is relationship between Mardell's father and mother as I've found no shared matches to both lines
